### **BLUE HILLS EARLY YEARS HUB**

#### Changes to car parking

As has been previously advised, Knox Council will be redeveloping the Blue Hills Early years hub, with work commencing in the new year. As from 1st February 2018 the current car park at the rear of Blue Hills will no longer be part of the Bayswater Bowls club. A new park has been constructed at the rear of the club and parking will also be available on the club side of the drive to rear of club.

- As part of managing traffic and parking issues during the construction of the Bayswater Early Years hub, the following instructions will be issued to the contractors:
  - All construction traffic will be required to access the site via Phyllis Street from Stud Road.
  - Deliveries (large vehicles, concrete trucks, etc.) will be restricted to outside of Primary School drop-off and pick-up times.
  - On Bowls club days (Tuesday and Saturday), deliveries to site to be restricted to designated hours and subcontractors directed to park in the Guy Turner carpark, or within the compound which will be situated on the rear of the existing carpark. Site supervisory personnel to utilise 4 existing parking bays on the site frontage to Phyllis Street.
- Street signage will be installed at access roadway entry prohibiting primary school traffic from parking on site during construction period.
- There may be other means to minimise congestion and maximise parking for the bowls club; this will be discussed with the contractor once appointed.
