## **GREENS DIRECTOR & PROJECT OFFICER REPORT**

We have had problems with our no. 2 green in relation to the work being carried out by the contractors building the access ramp and the refurbishment of the front car park, clay and dust is covering the surface of the green.

Knox Council have agreed to pay for the green to be groomed and to that effect we have sprayed the green to also get rid of the algae and moss but the contractors are unable to groom the green until is totally dry.

The access ramp and car park are complete, we need to clean up areas on the green surround and some paving is required.

Landscaping will be undertaken around the areas to the access ramp with some climbing plants on the safety fences and

trees along the length of the parking bays. Firstly we will need to lay weed mat on all exposed garden areas and cover with mulch. To this end we intend to organize a Sunday morning working bee and will be asking for members help to complete this task.

Regarding the rear car park entrance we have now designed a ramp from the car park surface to the paved area at the rear of the clubhouse which will be to council regulations and as soon as the old shed is removed we will be installing this ramp.

We received the grant because we intend to use them while holding a Post Covid Community Participation Programme in October as part of our barefoot bowls Fridays. We will be inviting a wide range of local organisations to participate to encourage them to get out an enjoy each other's company again. Part of the money will go towards publicising the event. ### **ROOKIE ROLLERS**

We were happy to partner with our neighbour, Bayswater West Primary School, in the Rookie Rollers initiative of Bowls Australia where the kids, from prep to Grade 6, learn the principles of our sport, beginning with the simple concept of rolling a ball, and involving various activities, drills and games designed to teach them about pace and bias, using special bowls made out of rubber which are easy for small hands to handle, until eventually they reach the stage where they can actually play the game. Eight full days of 9 a.m. to 3.30 pm saw 150 pupils each make four visits to be club, together with teaching staff. It's planned that when the weather improves to have an event involving their parents, who've no doubt heard plenty about us!
